



## Manitoba 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Travel Health Conference April 22 & 23, 2010

The Winnipeg Regional Health Authority, Travel Health & Tropical Medicine Services proudly presents its Manitoba 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Travel Health Conference. This conference is offered with the support of the Manitoba Travel Health Network, and is intended for all those who practice or are interested in the discipline of Travel Medicine and Infectious Diseases; in particular travel medicine health care practitioners, medical practitioners, nurses, pharmacists, and students who practice travel medicine within fields of Primary Care, Occupational Medicine, Infectious Diseases and Tropical Medicine, Emergency Medicine as well as Public Health Medicine.

The two-day conference will take place on April 22 & 23, 2010 at the Hotel Fort Garry, located at 222 Broadway Street, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada.

The Travel Health Conference will offer a variety of sessions by travel medicine experts, focusing on both pre and post travel issues, as they relate to their practice. Nationally and Provincially renowned speakers in the field of Travel Medicine and Infectious Diseases will be highlighted, including such speakers as **Dr. Kevin Kain**, (Malaria -What's New; Tropical Medicine Research – The Cutting Edge; Emerging Infectious Diseases – What's Hot), **Dr. Pierre Plourde** (Update on the Committee to Advise on Tropical Medicine and Travel; Visiting Friends and Relatives; Envenomation), **Dr. Paul VanCaesele** (Rapid Point of Care Testing Technologies), **Dr. Philippe Lagacé-Wiens** (Confessions of a Mosquito: My Life with Yellow Fever; It's Raining Bats & Dogs: Rabies and Travel), **Dr. Glen Drobot** (Experiences in Kampala, Uganda); **Dr. Maryanne Crockett** ( Travel Related Infections in Canadian Children); and **Dr. Nichole Riese** (Medicine Sans Frontiers - General Information/Personal Experiences).

Early conference registration is \$210.00 by April 1, 2010 or \$265.00 after April 2, 2010. For the first time, we will also be offering a one day early registration fee of \$160 or \$185 for late registration. Student fees will also be available.
